Thank You

On April 26, 2022, Mayor Pierce and the Eagle City Council directed staff to negotiate a trash contract with a new service provider. **Our last day of service will be December 31, 2022.** We greatly appreciate our 25-year partnership and will miss you. Together, we developed the most sophisticated solid waste program in Idaho. To date, we:

- Built Idaho's first "Pay-As-You-Throw" system, which empowered residents to treat trash like a utility. The three cart sizes meet everyone's needs, from seniors and veterans, to fiscally-conscious and environmentally-minded residents.
- Launched curbside spring and post-holiday cleanup events to give all residents an opportunity to purge large items and appliances from home.
- Replaced 100% of our diesel fleet with clean-burning trucks powered by renewable natural gas (RNG), generated by dairies in the Magic Valley. The transition from carbon-intensive diesel to carbon-negative RNG reduces our environmental impact and protects local air quality. To further address climate change, we added ten U.S. manufactured, zero-emission electric trucks to our local fleet.
- Improved recycling from 18-gallon blue bins with separated materials to all-in-one blue carts allowing mixed recyclables.
- Added quarterly household hazardous waste collection events.

- Donated \$122,500 in services to support Eagle Fun Days, Eagle Island State Park, Eagle Kiwanis, the Eagle Chamber, the Eagle Senior Center, the Eagle Fire Department, the Eagle BMX Park and the Eagle Rodeo.
- Gave the City of Eagle \$103,600 in alternative fuel tax credits for community investment.
- Added glass and plastic water bottle recycling drop-off sites
- Invested over \$675,000 during the economic downturn to keep the City of Eagle's recycling program intact. Despite market volatility, we remain committed to recycling as an environmentally sound decision.
- Wrote the Hefty Energy Bag Grant to help Eagle residents recover energy from hard-to-recycle plastics.
- Added subscription composting.

What's Changing

Our last service day will be December 31, 2022.

- Republic Services® will collect empty recycling, trash and compost carts the first two weeks of January.
- Empty carts will be collected on your current service day, not your new service day. Please make sure carts are empty, because we will not have recycling or trash trucks in Eagle to empty them as of January 1, 2023.
- Leave carts at the curb until they are collected. Cart removal crews may run into delays that require removal the next service day.

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- Cart removal crews will document houses that do not have carts placed at the curb for removal. Our customer service team will contact households with carts still on site after January 15, 2023 to schedule a final removal date. Customers will be invoiced for carts not returned to Republic Services by January 31, 2023.
